

Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH).

Hereby we inform that our products are developed and produced with the European Union Regulation No. 1907/2006 (REACH, Registration, Evaluation and Authorization of Chemicals).

To our current knowledge and based on the information received from our suppliers, we confirm that all our parts are in compliance with European Union Regulation No. 1907/2006 and do not contain any of the 240 Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) of the last ECHA-list in a concentration above 0,1% (w/w).

We are in constant contact with our suppliers. If we receive a notification that an article exceeds the allowed limits, we will immediately inform customers concerned to article 33.
